I hereby nominate: _____ for the following 2009 Central Florida Chapter of the American Society for Public Administration Award to be announced during Public Service Recognition Week (*please check only one (1) nomination per form*):

___ **Public Service Award**

Recognizes an individual, private institution, or public organization in Central Florida for promoting the role, ethics, and ideals of public administration. The individual may be in a volunteer capacity.

___ **Public Administrator/New Professional Award**

Recognizes a public administrator with less than five years of full-time service in the public or nonprofit sector who has made a significant impact on the Central Florida community and to public or nonprofit service. The nominee may be in a volunteer capacity.

___ **Academic Excellence Award**

Recognizes an individual, from any institution in Central Florida, who has made a significant contribution to public administration through teaching, research, writing, and/or related activities.

___ **Student Essay Award**

Recognizes the University of Central Florida undergraduate or graduate student who submits the best essay of 500 words or less on the following topic:

“You are not inhibited by cost or difficulty. Imagine and describe the field of public administration in Central Florida in the year 2020. What you envision must be desirable, and motivating (you want to make it happen). What do you see? What is needed to make this happen? What are the barriers to making this happen?”

A one (1) page summary must be included with this nomination form. The summary should address:

- Why the individual or organization nominated deserves this award (including eligibility)
- The nominee’s accurate address and telephone number/s
- Any additional materials which may be required for this award (e.g., essay)

Nominees must live or work in Central Florida, defined as the service area of the University of Central Florida. Self-nominees will be accepted. Nominators must be members of the Central Florida Chapter of the American Society for Public Administration. Nominees are not required to be members of the Central Florida Chapter of the American Society for Public Administration. Nominations will be reviewed by the Chapter Awards Committee and award winning nominations and essay/s will be subject to publication.
