The Department of Political Science at Eastern Michigan University invites applications for a tenure track position at the Assistant Professor level, beginning August 2012.

Preferred candidates will have a doctoral degree or be ABD in Public Administration, Public Policy, Political Science, or other relevant fields and demonstrate a strong commitment to both teaching and research. Candidates are sought with a primary specialization in public budgeting and financial management. Secondary fields may be drawn from the following: methodology and policy analysis, organization theory, program evaluation, ethics, information technology, or nonprofit management. Expertise should be demonstrated through doctoral transcripts and/or professional experience.

Responsibilities include teaching courses in the Department's undergraduate public administration major, our NASPAA-accredited Master of Public Administration program (on our main campus in Ypsilanti and an off-site campus in nearby Livonia, Michigan), and graduate certificates in General Public Management, Public Personnel, Public Budget, Management of Public Healthcare Services, Public Land Planning and Development Management, Local Government Management, and Public Policy Analysis.

A complete application should include curriculum vitae, graduate transcripts, at least three current letters of reference, and samples of scholarship, course syllabi, and student evaluations (items can be combined in files for uploading).
