

TENURE TRACK ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION PACE UNIVERSITY

Pace University invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in the Department of Public Administration to begin September 1, 2009. The Department's Master of Public Administration Program has served the public management community in Westchester County for over 25 years. The program offers an MPA with tracks in Government Management, Health Care Administration, Non-Profit Administration and Environmental Management. The Department is also affiliated with the Edwin G. Michaelian Institute for Public Policy and Management as well as the Helene & Grant Wilson Center for Social Entrepreneurship.

The successful candidate will hold an earned doctorate in public administration, political science, or a closely related field. He/she will teach courses which include but are not limited to least one course in either Introduction to Public Administration or Organization Theory, the candidate will select according to the departmental needs between: Law in the Administrative Process, Policy Studies, Intergovernmental Relations, The History of Nonprofit Management, and Management Issues in Nonprofit Organizations. A commitment to student-centered learning and demonstrated excellence in teaching is required as well as evidence of an active research agenda. Area of specialization is open but we are especially interested in receiving applications in government or health care management. The position will begin September 1, 2010, pending budgetary approval.
